



Keep Mandeville Beautiful Anti-Litter Art Contest

Students in grades K-3rd in Mandeville are encouraged to create a poster with an anti-litter message. Creativity, attractiveness, and effectiveness of the message is important.

Use 8 ½ X 11 inch paper or poster cut to that size.

Crayons, markers, paint, or pencil colors are acceptable.

DUE DATE: Students must submit artwork to their school by February 14th. A school judge will select the top 4 in each grade level (16 total) and submit them to KMB by February 21st. City level judging to be held on February 25th. Winners will be notified through their school on February 28th.

AWARDS: KMB will issue certificates to all the school level winners. Winners at the city level will receive a trophy presented by the Mayor and City Council at the March 24th city council meeting. In addition, KMB will select some artwork to appear in a 2012 KMB calendar. The calendar will be sold as a fundraiser for the organization. KMB has sole discretion as to which pieces will appear in the calendar.

- Note to schools: Your school's winning entries (16 total) are due to Keep Mandeville Beautiful (1100 Mandeville High Blvd.) for city-wide judging on February 21st. Be sure the entry form is attached to the back of art work.
